

PDMC Beginner Wind and Brass Workshop The Octagon, Buxton, Friday 4 April 2025

Dear Head Teacher/Music Lead

Thank you for signing up to our Wind and Brass Workshop on Friday 4 April at The Octagon, Buxton.

Music and preparation

The workshop will be led by Helen Minshall from pBone (Classic FM Visiting Music Teacher of the Year 2024), assisted by our wind and brass Ensemble Director team and supported by some of our most accomplished young musicians.

There will be a number of musical games and activities and the participants will rehearse together two pieces to perform at the short 'Sharing Session' at the end of the event. These pieces are 'Jurassic Park' and 'All Shook Up'. To get the most out of the morning, we would like participants to have a go at playing these pieces in advance. You can find parts and backing tracks on our Wind Workshop webpage www.pdmc.org.uk/wind2025. There are a number of parts for each instrument from first notes to more advanced parts. You are welcome to choose the parts that work best for your pupils. If you are not able to find a suitable part on the web page please let me know. You are welcome to share this web page with your CIL deliverer/instrument teachers etc for the purposes of helping your pupils to prepare for this event.

Logistical information

Arrival time- Can you please arrive between 10.00am and 10.15am, to be seated and ready to start at 10.30am. We would like schools to enter using the doors directly in to the Octagon from the Promenade. Our team will be there to welcome you.

Event finish- The event will finish at 12 noon. There will be approximately 130 children taking part so it will take a few minutes for everyone to leave the building.

Sharing session- The event will finish with a short sharing session for parents/carers from 11.45am to 12 noon. We would love you to invite parents/carers to come along and have attached a letter that you can use if you wish. There is no charge for this and no tickets required but due to numbers we will have to limit the audience to two (not including younger siblings that parents may need to bring) per participating child. We would like parents to enter via the Octagon Lounge (there will be signs on the day) where they will be able to wait until they are admitted to the performance area.

What to bring- Pupils should bring their instruments and may bring a refillable water bottle if they wish. If schools consider that pupils will need a snack they may invite pupils to bring one, but **due to participants with allergies can you please ask that no-one brings any food containing nuts.**

Accompanying adults- Schools will be responsible for supervising their pupils and may bring as many adults as needed. We do not require that schools bring their CIL deliverer, although they would be very welcome.

Toilets- The only toilets available will be the public toilets at the Octagon (up the stairs opposite the Buxton Cinema, or accessible toilets by the Icecream Parlour). We will show you where these are when you arrive.

Instruments- Pupils will each need to have their own instrument to bring to the workshop. The workshop will be tailored to the instruments and number of children that schools have indicated on their sign up form. If you wish to bring any additional instruments and/or additional pupils please contact us in advance.

Transport- We are not able to provide transport to and from this event but there is parking at the venue for any schools who wish to bring a mini-bus or arrange their own coach.
