Pre- concert rehearsals	5:35pm- arrive at the Octagon and sign in (if not already on site for the workshop) 5:46pm –first rehearsal	Rehearsal time is very limited so please can all singers arrive promptly and be ready to play
Breaks	There will be some short breaks between the rehearsals and the concert.  Choir singers will remain in the Octagon, supervised by our team throughout their	
Meals/snacks	breaks.  We recommend that singers bring a packed tea if they have not had time to eat before they arrive, and any snacks/drinks that they might want	There will not be time for choir singers to visit shops/cafes etc
Other items	Singers may wish to bring a book or quiet game to play during breaks.	
Dress Code	Sara will let choir singers know about dress code.	There is no dressing room available so could players please come in their concert dress.
Concert	The concert will start at 7.00pm  Tickets are available to buy in advance from the Opera House. We will let you know when tickets go on sale.  If there are spare tickets, audience members will also be able to pay on the door but we would recommend booking in advance to avoid disappointment.  Price £15.00 per adult (no concessions), under 16s free (but ticket still required).	This will be a public concert, so everyone is welcome to come and watch. Please do invite your family and friends!  If paying for a ticket to watch may be difficult, please indicate on the consent form for more details of how to get a free or discounted ticket
Collection:	The concert ends at 9.20pm. If your child is being collected by someone who is not attending the concert, they should wait by the main doors to the Octagon.	Arrangements for audience members collecting players will be announced during the concert.
