

## PDMC Bursary Terms 2022/23

The Trustees of PDMC believe that no child should miss out on musical opportunities due to family financial circumstances. Each Bursary application will be considered by a panel of Trustees. If they need any additional information in order to make a fair decision we will contact you. If you are awarded a Bursary for the cost of instrument lessons, we will ask your teacher to invoice PDMC directly.

If your child is awarded a Bursary we ask that:

- 1. Your child applies themselves conscientiously to their music making with us, including attending rehearsals regularly
- 2. Your child has regular lessons on their chosen instrument and practices regularly
- 3. You inform us if your financial circumstances change

If your bursary includes help with the cost of instrument lessons we also ask that your child attends their lessons regularly and plays in an ensemble (this does not need to be a PDMC ensemble).

All bursaries will be reviewed before the start of each academic year.
